Dear *Colleague,*


Please refer to my D.O. letters of even number dated 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2017, 28<sup>th</sup> August, 2017, 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 and 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2017 requesting therein to complete the task of revision of pension cases of pre-2016 pensioners/family pensioners in a time bound manner and furnish progress report to the Board. The Zones listed in Annexure-I have not started work for revision of pension of pre-2016 pensioners. The progress in revision of pension in the remaining Zones (Annexure-II) is far from satisfactory. This has been seriously viewed by the Board. The target date for revision of pension cases of pre-2016 pensioners/family pensioners was set at 30.09.2017, which is already over. Hence, it is imperative to expedite the pending cases within the next three weeks.

2. The Board has received D.O. reminders letter No. 213/2/3/2017-Cab.III dated 16.10.2017 and No. 4/23/2017-P&PW(D) dated 03.10.2017 from Cabinet Secretary and Joint Secretary, Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare respectively (copies enclosed), which show the urgency and seriousness of the matter.

3. You are, therefore, requested to personally look into the matter and ensure that action is taken to complete the task of revision of pension and send report by

15<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 in this regard by e-mail at [commrcoord-cbec@nic.in](mailto:commrcoord-cbec@nic.in) and [amarjit.s@nic.in](mailto:amarjit.s@nic.in).

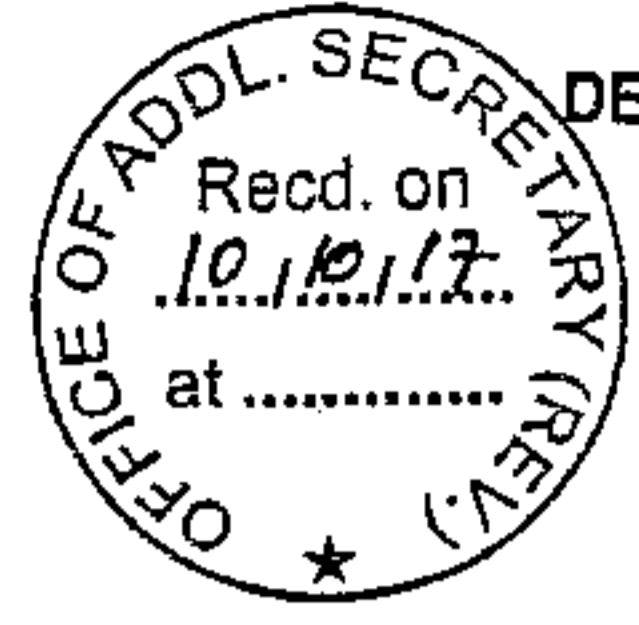

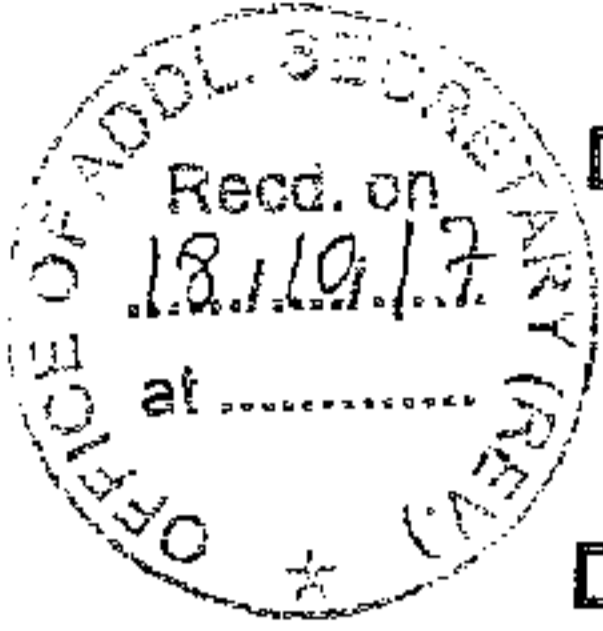

Dear Secretary,

As you are aware, based on the recommendation of the 7<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission, as accepted by the Government, pay of serving Government servants has been revised. Further, the pension of those who retired before 01.10.2016 is to be revised on the basis of notional pay fixation in terms of the relevant orders issued by Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare.

2. Finance Secretary has brought to my notice that the progress towards revision of pension of those who retired before 01.10.2016 is not satisfactory. I have been informed that Department of Pension of Pensioners' Welfare and Department of Expenditure have issued a number of instructions advising the Departments concerned to accord high priority to this exercise, in the interest of pensioners.

3. I would urge you to please ensure that an effective mechanism is put in place in your Department so that these pension cases are processed in a time-bound manner. You may also like to review the progress of pension revision cases in the weekly Senior Officers' Meetings.
