

Sir/Madam,

This has reference to this Department's letter of even number dated 5th March, 2012 where it informed that the manner of pay fixation of pay of Inspectors / similarly placed officials under CBEC consequent upon grant of revised pay structure of the grade pay of Rs.4600/- in PB-2, drawing reference from DOPT OM No.7/7/2008-CS.I(A) dated 22.12.2010 and 18.3.2011, will be issued separately in consultation with Department of Expenditure/Department of Personnel & Training.

2. The aforesaid issue has been examined in consultation with the Department of Expenditure. It has been decided that the pay fixation of the officials who have been granted the upgraded Grade Pay in the revised pay structure has to be strictly done as per Rule 7 of CCS (RP) Rules, 2008. Further, provisions contained in Department of Expenditure's UO No. 10/1/2009-IC dated 14.12.2009 cannot be extended to the Inspectors / similarly placed officials under CBEC.
