Sub: Preparation of panel for appointment of Senior Intelligence Officer/
Intelligence Officer on deputation basis in the Directorate of
Revenue Intelligence (DRI), Regional Unit, Mangalore – reg.

The Directorate of Revenue Intelligence Unit, Zonal Unit, Bangalore is in the process of drawing a panel of willing and suitable candidates for filling up one vacancy of Senior Intelligence Officer (SIO) and two vacancies of Intelligence Officers (IO) at Regional Unit, Mangalore on deputation basis. It is proposed to fill up these vacancies by appointing suitable officers from the grade of Superintendents/Inspector of Customs & Central GST.

2. The selected officers, while working in the DRI in the grade of SIO/IO on deputation basis, will be entitled for Deputation Allowance, as admissible. Normally, the Deputation is for a period of five years, which is extendable by another two years, subject to the willingness of the officers,

his/her performance, and the concurrence of his/her parent Commissionerate and approval of the competent authority. It may be made clear to the willing officers that the option once exercised would be final and in the event of selection, they will not be allowed to withdraw the same. The selected officers will have to make their own arrangements for residential accommodation.

3. Further, as per Para IV of Ministry's F.No.A-35017/28/92.AD.IIIB dated 30.06.1994 officers posted in certain charges/organisation/assignments are required to complete the "Cooling Off" period of not less than two years before posting in DRI. However, the concerned Chief Commissioner of Customs/Central GST/Preventive has been given the power to relax the "Cooling Off" period.

4. It is requested that the circular may please be brought to the notice of all the formations under your jurisdiction and the applications of willing officers be forwarded to this office. While forwarding the names of the willing officers, the following information may also be sent for evaluation by this Directorate.

- (a) Complete bio-data and willingness of the officer along with history of postings;
- (b) ACR/APAR grading for the last five (5) years duly verified and attested by the Additional/Joint Commissioner (P & V)
- (c) Vigilance Clearance

5. The above information/details may kindly be arranged to be furnished to this office at the earliest, preferably by 28.02.2018.
