Subject: Publication of FAQs on Goods & Sarvices Tax in regional languages.

As you are aware, the 101× Amendment to the Constitution of India has created the legal framework for implementation of the Goods and Services Tax – a single Indirect Tax replacing a multitude of Central and State levies. The Government intends to introduce GST w.e.f. to April, 2017. For the benefit of departmental officers and members of trade and industry and public, CBEC has propared the FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions) on GST, which was released by the Honourable Finance Minister on 21.9.2016. The FAQs on GST (available on CBEC website) has been widely appreciated, in order to ensure that the nature, features and provisions of the new tax measure namely GST is understood by people speaking different languages across the country, it is imperative that the FAQs on GST is made available in Hindi / regional (anguages.
